4.	<p>Sworn statement by the prospective bidder or its duly authorized representative in the form prescribed as to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) The <b>signatory</b> is the duly authorized representative of the prospective bidder, and granted <b>full power and authority to do, execute and perform any and all acts necessary</b> and/or to represent the prospective bidder in the bidding;</li> <li>(b) Duly notarized <b>Secretary's Certificate</b> attesting to such fact, if the prospective bidder is a corporation, partnership, cooperative, or joint venture or Special Power of Attorney (SPA) for sole proprietorship;</li> <li>(c) It is <b>not "blacklisted"</b> or barred from bidding by the GOP or any of its agencies, offices, corporations, or LGUs, including foreign government/foreign or international financing institution whose blacklisting rules have been recognized by the GPPB;</li> <li>(d) Each of the documents submitted in satisfaction of the bidding requirements is an <b>authentic copy</b> of the original, complete, and all statements and information provided therein are true and correct;</li> <li>(e) It is authorizing the <b>Head of the Procuring Entity</b> or his <b>duly authorized representative/s</b> to verify all the documents submitted;</li> <li>(f) It complies with the <b>disclosure provision</b> under Section 47 of the Act in relation to other provisions of R.A. 3019;</li> <li>(g) It complies with existing <b>labor laws and standards</b>;</li> <li>(h) It complies with the <b>responsibilities of a prospective or eligible bidder</b> provided in the bidding documents: and</li> <li>(i) It did not give or pay directly or indirectly, any commission, amount, fee, or any form of consideration, pecuniary or otherwise, to any person or official, personnel or representative of the government in relation to any procurement project or activity.</li> </ul>	

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
